**PRIZE FOR INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION
1ST EDITION**

The International Centre for Arbitration, Mediation and Negotiation (CIAMEN) of the Institute for European Studies of the CEU San Pablo University in Madrid (IDEE), with the collaboration of the Second Vice-Presidency and the Madrid Regional Ministry for Justice and Home Affairs, *PromoMadrid, Desarrollo Internacional de Madrid, S.A.* and *Ocaso Insurance* are launching this first edition of the Prize for International Arbitration, to award and publicise best technical works in this field, in accordance with the following criteria:

CRITERIA

ONE PRESENTATION OF WORKS, CONDITIONS AND REQUISITES

Works presented as candidacies for the prize may discuss any aspect of international arbitration and must contain unpublished commentaries in Spanish, English, French or German with a maximum length of fifty A4 pages.

All papers must be presented on sheets of A4, printed on both sides, in Times New Roman font, size 12, 1.5 spacing, and with text justified, with endnotes, an index and bibliography.

Three copies of the work must be sent by certified mail, under a pseudonym, together with an electronic copy in Word format. In a separate envelope, signed with the pseudonym on the front of the envelope and sealed, an additional original signed copy of the work must be delivered, together with a form completed with the personal details and a short curriculum vitae of the candidate. In the case of work groups, the form completed with personal details and a short CV must be provided for each member of the work group.

Works presented that do not comply with these requisites will not be considered.

TWO CANDIDATES

Any individual or group can present a candidacy. Each individual or work group may present one or more papers.

THREE PRIZE

Only one prize of 12,000 euros shall be awarded, granted by the CIAMEN, with financing provided by *PromoMadrid, Desarrollo Internacional de Madrid, S.A.* and *Ocaso Insurance* and the collaboration of the Second Vice-Presidency and Madrid Regional Ministry for Justice and Home Affairs.

Applicable current tax regulations shall be applied on granting the prize.

**FOUR
SENDING APPLICATIONS. DEADLINE AND PLACE OF DELIVERY**

The deadline for receipt of applications is no later than 8pm on the 16th of January 2008. Papers must be delivered to the Secretary of the International Centre for Arbitration, Mediation and Negotiation (CIAMEN), of the Institute for European Studies at the following address:

SELECTION PANEL**

The selection panel shall be comprised of five members, three of which shall be designated by the CIAMEN, and two designated by the Second Vice-Presidency and Madrid Regional Ministry for Justice and Home Affairs and by PromoMadrid, Desarrollo Internacional de Madrid, S.A., respectively.

**SIX
SELECTION CRITERIA**

The International Arbitration Prize shall be granted to the best work presented in the field of international arbitration. The selection panel shall evaluate the quality and technical content of the works, as well as the originality of the approach and contributions they make to advances in the study of this legal specialism.

**SEVEN
CONCLUSION AND PRIZEGIVING**

The winner of the 1st Edition of the Prize for International Arbitration shall be notified by post in writing.

Following this, a brief mention of the prize and the winner shall be published in the media.

The selection panel reserves the right not to award the prize. The decision of the selection panel is final.

The prize shall be awarded in the public ceremony which shall take place in the premises of the Madrid Regional Government following the public announcement of the winner.

EIGHT PUBLICATION OF THE WORKS

The awarded work shall be published by the CIAMEN, as well as electronically, by PromoMadrid. Originals of the works which have not been awarded shall not be returned and shall remain with the CIAMEN for possible publication in hard copy or electronic format on the website of the Institute for European Studies of the CEU San Pablo University (www.ideo.ceu.es) and on the arbitration website of PromoMadrid (www.promomadrid.com).

NINE PERSONAL DETAILS

The personal details of the participants shall be provided to the Institute for European Studies and to PromoMadrid, which shall include them in their contact databases, duly registered with the Spanish Agency for Data Protection.

The organisations responsible for these data are the Institute for European Studies and PromoMadrid. The data may be published on the website of the Institute for European Studies of the CEU San Pablo University (www.ideo.ceu.es) and on the arbitration website of PromoMadrid (www.madridarbitration.com) and shall be used to send, by any means, information regarding arbitration and any other activities which may be considered of interest to the participants.
